Dearest Hyer Families,

It was a joyous few days last week welcoming all of our huskies to the 2024-2025 school year for Homerun Hyer! The teachers and I were so impressed by the positivity and enthusiasm of each child as they came into school and adapted to their schedules and school routines with ease.



**Beginning today**, Monday, Kindergarten - 4th grade students arriving between 7:30 and 7:45, will go to the gym; students will be dismissed from the gym to go to their classrooms at 7:45. Preschool students will enter through their door on Colgate beginning at 7:45. We encourage you to let your students walk into the building and go to the gym or their classrooms independently. This often helps with separation anxiety and fosters confidence in our younger students.

Each day, dismissal runs a little more smoothly. We are grateful for your assistance in following the established procedures found on the <u>Hyer</u> <u>website</u>.

We know many of our families have to pick up students at two campuses so if that applies to you, you will want to arrive early to the carpool line on Caruth.

To our families who park on a side street and walk to school to pick up/meet your child, we kindly ask that you wait for your student on the side of the front lawn where your child's grade level is dismissed, and the direction of where you have parked your car. The classroom teacher will dismiss your child to where you are standing. Please do not walk over to the teacher to get your student as she is also managing students who are being called for carpool. Our goal is to ensure each student safely connects with their parent or guardian.

We ask that you not walk across the front sidewalk on Caruth during dismissal as this is reserved for students getting into cars in the carpool lane. Please do not park on either side of Colgate. Dismissal on Colgate is reserved for preschool pick-up, handicap accessible pick up, and 2nd-4th grade students who may have younger siblings, and are walking or riding bikes with or without an adult.

Please, please, please for your safety, the safety of our students and to be a positive role model, **do not cross in the middle of the street** on either Caruth or Colgate. We kindly request that you use the crosswalks and cross the street with one of our incredible crossing guards.

Remember that school starts at 7:55 AM. When students arrive on time, it sets a positive tone for the day.

We are all adjusting to the routines and procedures of being in school. Each parent/guardian and Hyer staff member plays an important role in our drop off and pick up procedures. Please reach out to your child's teacher if you have questions about arrival or dismissal.

The Hyer staff and I are truly blessed to be part of this amazing community and are delighted to work with you and your children this year.





#### **Visitor and Birthday Policy**

Hyer has tables inside as well as outside, in Balto's Courtyard, if you would like to have lunch with your student during their lunch period. We ask that you wait until September 3rd to join your child for lunch so our students have an opportunity to learn the procedures in our cafeteria and connect with their classmates and new friends. If your child has a birthday before September 3rd, we are happy to make an exception so you can join him/her for lunch on his/her birthday.

All students in grades K-4th can invite ONE student friend to have lunch with them and their parent guest. This is a change from prior years. If you join your child for lunch, please only provide lunch for your child, not the friend who is joining them. Please adhere to these guidelines so as not to cause hurt feelings.

While dining with your child, please remember to follow school cafeteria rules, even in the courtyard. It can be dangerous to have children running around, jumping off of benches, etc.

We celebrate every child's birthday with special recognition on the morning announcements and in the classroom. Because of food allergies and nutritional guidelines, parents are asked not to bring birthday treats to distribute to other students in the class, either in the classroom or in the cafeteria.

#### Lunch Selection and Menu Options

Students in grades Kindergarten and 1st will have the option to buy either a hot or cold lunch each day. Students in grades 2nd - 4th will have the option to purchase items à la carte. Meat, vegetables, salads, sandwiches, fruits, milk, and juices are available each day.

Ice cream/popsicles are served on certain days in the cafeteria. This service will begin on **SEPTEMBER 23rd** to give all students time to adjust to cafeteria. Below are the days/grades for when ice cream/popsicles will be offered:

- K: Fridays only
- 1st: Fridays only
- 2nd: Tuesdays and Thursdays

- 3rd: Tuesdays/Thursdays/Fridays
- 4th: Tuesdays/Thursdays/Fridays


