SAVE THE DATE FOR DADS CLUB BBQ COOK OFF ON OCTOBER 21!

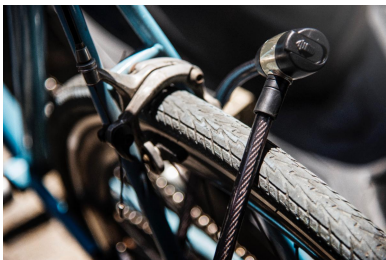

The food drive ends this Friday, October 6th. Donation bins are located in the hallways and at the Caruth entrance.

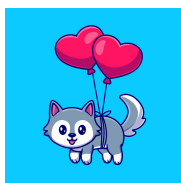
