The night before...

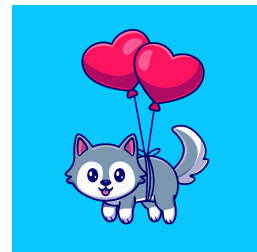

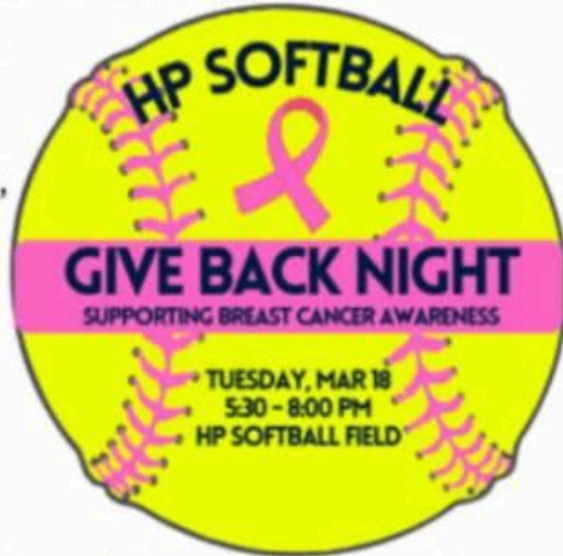
HP LADY SCOTS SOFTBALL TEAM
