The 4th Grade KC Club (Kindness and Compassion Club) is collecting individual snack items to benefit the children served by **Vogel Alcove**. Vogel Alcove is a non-profit organization helping young children and their families overcome the lasting and traumatic effects of homelessness.

KC Club members will use the snack items to assemble paper bag "snack packs," which will be distributed by Vogel Alcove to the children in their program. Tomorrow is the last day to contribute snack items to the drive! Donation boxes are located in each grade level pod. "Snack packs" provide vital additional nutrition and bridge any gap between meals. They are often used to keep children satiated and occupied on long DART commutes from Vogel Alcove to the shelter where their family resides.

Please purchase items according to the grade level breakdown below. This will ensure we cover all the necessary items to complete a nutritional snack pack bag. You do not need to assemble the snack packs, just bring your assigned item to the collection bins in the grade level pods.

- PreK, Kinder & 1st Grade: Individual size Go-Go Squeeze, Apple Sauce Cups or Fruit Strips/Snacks
- 2nd Grade: Individual Bags of either Goldfish

Crackers, Cheese Crackers (no Peanut Butter) or Individual servings of cereal such as Cheerios

- 3rd Grade: Mini bottles of water, Capri Suns or Roaring Waters
- 4th Grade: Bumble Bee Snack on the Run -Chicken Salad Kit with Crackers
