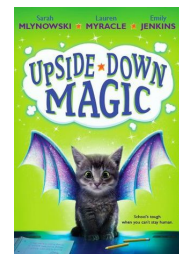

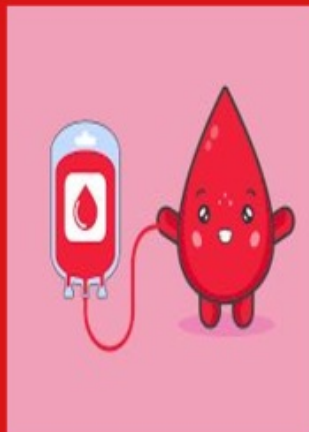

## THIS WEEK IS HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE WEEK



January 24 - 28 is Holocaust Remembrance Week. Legislation signed by Governor Greg Abbott requires public schools to establish Holocaust

Remembrance Week to educate students about the Holocaust and inspire in students a sense of responsibility to recognize and uphold human value and to prevent future atrocities. The State has charged the Texas Holocaust and Genocide Commission to provide materials for teacher use that are age-appropriate for the students they serve. The approach recommended for teachers in grades pre-K through 6 is to provide an understanding of terms and concepts such as **being an upstander, tolerance, community, and anti-bullying** during this week. This remembrance supports the district's commitment to **inclusive and respectful schools**.

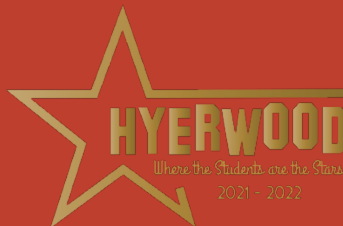
