



WELCOME TO SIGNUP.COM - HYER'S NEW VOLUNTEER SCHEDULING PROGRAM!




Hyer is rolling out the red carpet for an all-new webbased volunteer scheduling program, <u>Signup.com</u>, that will replace Volunteer Scheduler Pro (VSP). This new software promises to make creating, signing up for, and managing school volunteer opportunities easier and more convenient! From cafeteria volunteer and teacher workroom shifts to class

parties and PTA events, <u>Signup.com</u> will be the go-to spot for managing shifts.

Volunteers will be able to sign up for shifts in various ways, depending on the opportunity; for private events (such as class specific parties) volunteers may be sent an email invitation; for general school-wide events there may be an event specific volunteer link in the Husky Herald or on the PTA website.

Volunteers will not be required to create an account or download an app to sign up for and manage a shift – they will click through the emailed invitation or click on the event volunteer link, provide an email address, and sign up! Volunteers can access their activities through their confirmation Signup.com email, or by going to Signup.com, clicking "Find My Signup", and entering their email address. It is that simple!

Visitor and Birthday Policy

Hyer will have tables inside as well as outside, in Balto's Courtyard, if you would like to have lunch with your student during their lunch period. We ask that you wait until September 13 to join your child for lunch so our students have an opportunity to learn the procedures in our cafeteria and connect with their classmates and new friends. If your child has a birthday before September 13, we are happy to make an exception so you can join him/her for lunch on his/her birthday.



There are visitor-specific tables for parents who would like to eat lunch with their children. We kindly ask that parents not sit at class tables due to limited seating and student privacy. Please remember that Kindergarten through 3rd grade students can invite ONE student friend to have lunch with them and their parent guest. Fourth graders may invite TWO student friends to join them for

lunch. Please adhere to these guidelines so as not to cause hurt feelings.

We celebrate every child's birthday with special recognition on the morning announcements and in the classroom. Because of food allergies and nutritional guidelines, parents are asked not to bring birthday treats to distribute to other students in the class, either in the classroom or in the cafeteria.

Lunch Selection and Menu Options

Students in grades Kindergarten and 1st will have the option to buy either a hot or cold lunch each day. Students in grades 2nd - 4th will have the option to purchase items à la carte. Meat, vegetables, salads, sandwiches, fruits, milk, and juices are available each day.

About 15 minutes after the beginning of the lunch period, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade students are allowed to purchase ice cream for dessert. Kindergarten and 1st grade students are allowed to purchase ice cream for dessert on Fridays only. Second grade students can purchase ice cream on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Third and fourth grade students may purchase ice cream on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Students are not required to purchase lunch from the cafeteria and may bring a lunch from home.
