Dr. Housson has extensive experience diagnosing autism, attention disorders, learning disabilities, and emotional and behavioral disorders. He leads the clinical team at The Housson Center, which provides individual and family psychotherapy services to address behavioral and emotional concerns, as well as conducts psychoeducational and psychological assessments for children, adolescents, and adults.

Dr. Housson will address topics including:

- anxiety in kids
- the importance of sleep, exercise, family routines
- when to seek an external evaluation
- the value of both child and parent counseling/therapy

RING IN SPRING WITH PNOS ON MARCH 24 & 25!




