VOTE TOMORROW IN GOLDEN PENNY ELECTION!



Election Day is tomorrow, November 2. HPISD Proposition A is on the ballot, which gives voters the opportunity to increase teacher and staff compensation by authorizing

the use of 4 "golden pennies" that are not subject to the state's recapture formula.

- A majority vote **for** the golden pennies will decrease the tax rate by 2.1 cents per \$100 of assessed property value by setting a tax rate of \$1.131 and will generate about \$3.6 million to be used solely to increase teacher and staff compensation.
- A majority vote **against** the golden pennies will decrease the tax rate by 6.1 cents per \$100 of assessed property value and will set the tax rate at \$1.091. Last year's tax rate was \$1.1519.

Regardless of the election outcome, the tax rate will drop to a 5-year low. Click [HERE](#) for more information.

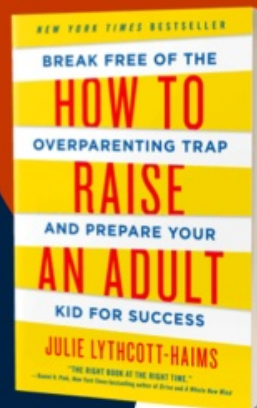

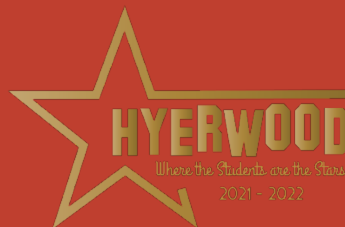
